## PRIVATE CHAPTER NO. 6

HOUSE BILL NO. 1422

AN ACT to amend Chapter 169 of the Private Acts of 1990; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to landfills in Lewis County.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 169 of the Private Acts of 1990, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended by deleting Section 1 and substituting instead the following:

SECTION 1. No landfill for the disposal of solid or hazardous wastes shall be located within four and one-half (4½) miles from the center of the Buffalo River on each side in Lewis County.

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of Lewis County. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the legislative body and certified to the secretary of state.


SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 2.
