AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 40, Chapter 15, relative to eligibility for certain diversion programs.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-15-105(a)(1)(B)(iii)(h), is amended by deleting the following language:

Any misdemeanor offense committed by any elected or appointed person in the executive, legislative or judicial branch of the state or any political subdivision of the state, which offense was committed in the person's official capacity or involved the duties of the person's office.

and substituting instead the following:

Any misdemeanor offense committed by any elected or appointed person or employee in the executive, legislative, or judicial branch of the state or any political subdivision of the state, which offense was committed in the person's official capacity or involved the duties of the person's office.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017, the public welfare requiring it.
