WHEREAS, no stranger to famous faces, Jimmy Kelly's Steakhouse has welcomed such luminaries as Bob Hope, Frank Sinatra, Dean Martin, Perry Como, Robert Redford, James Garner, Mel Gibson, Bryant Gumbel, Neil Young, Eddy Arnold, Chet Atkins, Toby Keith, Dolly Parton, Reba McEntire, k.d. lang, Bob Dylan, and many more; and
