WHEREAS, these three gallant gentlemen swiftly went into action when a sixty-seven-year-old resident of Hixson, traveling through LaGuardia Airport, suffered a heart attack while riding a shuttle bus outside Terminal C; and

WHEREAS, Officer Miranne, Officer Berrios, and Officer Oliveto responded to the situation, performing cardiopulmonary resuscitation and shocking the woman with a portable defibrillator; she began to breathe once the shock was administered and was later taken to Elmhurst Hospital; and


