A RESOLUTION to commend and congratulate Preston Rice of Wayne County High School upon receiving the 2016 Tennessee Titans Mr. Football Award, Division I Class 1A Back.

WHEREAS, from time to time, the members of this General Assembly pause in their deliberations to recognize those student-athletes who have displayed unmatched prowess on the fields of play; and

WHEREAS, Preston Rice, a member of the 2016 Wayne County High School football team, is one such individual who was recently awarded the 2016 Tennessee Titans Mr. Football Award, Division I Class 1A Back; and

WHEREAS, a star quarterback for the Wildcats, Mr. Rice led Wayne County to its last seven playoff wins and now holds the state record for most combined career rushing/passing touchdowns with 141; and

WHEREAS, responsible for the team's last sixteen playoff wins, members of the Rice family have enjoyed a tremendous run playing quarterback for Wayne County, as Preston's brothers, Tyler and Austin, combined to win nine playoff games for the Wildcats; and

WHEREAS, a true dual threat, Preston Rice compiled an amazing 10,249 yards combined, rushing and passing, in his high school career, which places him third on the all-time list for all classifications in Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, an eagle-eyed passer, Mr. Rice's career passing statistics include 367 completions out of 638 attempts for 7,619 total yards and ninety-three touchdowns against only twenty-six interceptions; and

WHEREAS, Preston Rice's accomplishments running the football are equally as impressive, as he gained 2,630 yards on 467 attempts to score forty-eight touchdowns for the Wayne County Wildcats during his career; and

WHEREAS, a winner both on and off the field of play, Mr. Rice is clearly deserving of the respect, admiration, and commendation of this legislative body; now, therefore,
