A RESOLUTION to honor the memory of Charles Thomas Tomlinson of Lebanon.

WHEREAS, nicknamed "Killer" by his colleagues, he had also served as chief deputy for the Wilson County Sheriff's Department, and after his retirement he worked part time as a court officer for the sheriff; and

WHEREAS, Chief Tomlinson was a member of Immanuel Baptist Church; and

WHEREAS, he was also deeply devoted to his family, and Chief Tomlinson always endeavored to remain true to family values of the highest order; and

WHEREAS, Charles Tomlinson is survived by his beloved wife of forty-eight years, Joyce Tisdale Tomlinson; daughter and son-in-law, Alyson and Geoff Atchley; cherished only grandchild and treasured namesake, Charley Atchley; mother, Aline Tomlinson; mother-in-law, Ruby Tisdale; brother and sister-in-law, Jim and Sharon Tomlinson; sisters and brother-in-law, Jewell and Dave Annable and Fran Planicka; nieces and nephews, Jill and Robert Crouch and family, John Annable, Tim Planicka, Amy Tomlinson, Macie Tomlinson, and Gavin Tomlinson; and special relatives, Brandi, Eugene, and Lauren McGee; and
