Proclamation 15-02
Proclaiming Happy Hollow Wildlife Management Area

Pursuant to the authority granted by Title 70, Tennessee Code Annotated, Sections 70-1-206 and 70-5-101, the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission hereby proclaims the following area as a wildlife management area to be known as the Happy Hollow Wildlife Management Area:

Happy Hollow Wildlife Management Area – Those lands and waters in west central Hickman County, north of the Duck River, bisected by State Route 50, south of Only, Tennessee, owned by the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency.

The boundary line is posted with "Wildlife Management Area" signs. A more complete description may be found in the Real Estate Division office of the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency, Nashville, Tennessee..
