Amendment to Proclamation 10-04
Importation of Cervid Carcasses and Parts

Pursuant to the authority granted by Tennessee Code Annotated Sections 70-4-107 and 70-5-108, the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Commission hereby amends Proclamation 10-04 as follows:

Specific CWD containment areas are redefined to read as follows:


The following U.S. states, portions of states, and Canadian provinces are proclaimed to be CWD positive and are therefore regulated by rule 1660-1-15:
