AN ACT to amend Chapter 429 of the Private Acts of 1931; as amended by Chapter 304 of the Private Acts of 1968; Chapter 104 of the Private Acts of 1993; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the charter of the City of Murfreesboro.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 429 of the Private Acts of 1931, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended in Article X, Section 56 by adding the following language after the first sentence:

The City Council may appoint the same person to hold the office of City Treasurer and the office of City Recorder.

SECTION 2. Chapter 429 of the Private Acts of 1931, as amended by Chapter 304 of the Private Acts of 1968, Chapter 104 of the Private Acts of 1993, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended in Article X, Section 58 by deleting the first sentence of the section in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

That, subject to the provisions of the foregoing section, and any ordinance or resolution of the council adopted in that regard, warrants shall be issued by the City Recorder and countersigned by the City Manager and Mayor.

SECTION 3. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of City of Murfreesboro. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the legislative body and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 4. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 3.
