AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 16, Chapter 18, Part 3, relative to municipal courts.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 16-18-302(a), is amended by deleting the language "Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary:" and substituting instead the following:

For any municipality that does not have, on the effective date of this act, a municipal court that was ordained and established by the general assembly, a municipal court is created to be presided over by a city judge. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary:

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
