AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-515, relative to social security identification numbers on documents.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-515, is amended by adding the following language as a new subsection thereto:

(g) A county register of deeds, in any county having a population of not less than three hundred eighty-two thousand (382,000) nor more than three hundred eighty-two thousand one hundred (382,100), according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census, or in any county having a population of not less than eight hundred thousand (800,000), according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census, or in any county having a population of not less than seventy-one thousand one hundred (71,100) nor more than seventy-one thousand two hundred (71,200), according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census, or in any county having a population of not less than one hundred five thousand eight hundred (105,800) nor more than one hundred five thousand nine hundred (105,900), according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census, may redact any social security number which is found on a recorded document maintained on a computer or removable computer storage media, including CD-ROM disks.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
