AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 5-6-101, relative to county chief executive officers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 5-6-101(d), is amended by adding the following language as a new subdivision (3):

(3) Notwithstanding subdivisions (1) and (2), in any county having a population of not less than twenty thousand one hundred (20,100) nor more than twenty thousand two hundred (20,200) according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census, the chief executive officer of the county shall be designated and hereafter referred to as the county executive.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
