AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 33, relative to a statewide admissions review committee for admissions to developmental centers for persons with intellectual or developmental disabilities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

- SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 33-5-301, is amended by deleting the language "admission review board" wherever it appears and replacing it with "statewide admission review committee".
- SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 33-5-301, is further amended by deleting the language "developmental disability" wherever it appears and replacing it with "intellectual or developmental disability".
- SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 33-5-301, is further amended by deleting the following language from subdivision (b)(1) in its entirety:
 - (1) Under department rules the chief officer of a developmental center, subject to the availability of suitable accommodations and the absence of a less restrictive alternative, may admit for diagnosis, care, training and treatment:

and by substituting the following:

- (1) Under department rules and pursuant to the direction of the statewide admission review committee, the chief officer or director of a center or the appointed designee of a developmental center, subject to the availability of suitable accommodations and the absence of a less restrictive alternative, may admit for diagnosis, care, training and treatment:
- SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 33-5-301, is further amended by deleting section (c) in its entirety; and substituting the following:
 - (c) The statewide admission review committee shall informally review a person's emergency respite admission within seven (7) days after the person is admitted. If the review is not done, then a hearing shall be held by the committee to review the propriety of the admission as in the case of regular voluntary admissions and shall make its decision within twenty-five (25) days after admission.
- SECTION 5. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 33-5-301, is further amended by adding a new subsection (e):
 - (e) The department may adopt rules to implement the statewide admissions review committee and to specify its duties and membership.
- SECTION 6. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 33-5-302, is amended by deleting the statutory language in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

The chief officer or director of a center or the appointed designee:

(1) Shall cause each person admitted under § 33-5-301 or transferred under § 33-3-301 or Chapter 3, Part 4 of this title to be evaluated as often as necessary, but not less often than every six (6) months;

- (2) Shall discharge a person admitted under § 33-5-301 when the chief officer, director or designee and the statewide admission review committee determine that the person no longer meets the standards under which the person was admitted; or
- (3) May discharge a person admitted under § 33-5-301 at any time when it is in his or her best interest.
- SECTION 7. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 33-5-303, is amended by deleting the language "developmental disability" wherever it appears and replacing it with "intellectual or developmental disability".
- SECTION 8. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 33-5-303, is further amended by deleting the language "chief officer" or "chief officer of the developmental center" wherever these terms appear and replacing them with "chief officer or director of a center or the appointed designee".
- SECTION 9. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 33-5-304, is amended by deleting the language "developmental disability" or "developmental disabilities" wherever these terms appear and replacing them with "intellectual or developmental disability" or "intellectual or developmental disabilities".
 - SECTION 10. This act shall take effect upon becoming law, the public welfare requiring it.
