AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 56-60-102(10), relative to include chiropractic physicians in the definition of the term "physician."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 56-60-102(10), is amended by deleting the subsection in its entirety and substituting instead the following language:

(10) "Physician" means any individual licensed as a chiropractic physician under Title 63, Chapter 4; a medical doctor under Title 63, Chapter 6; or an osteopathic physician under Title 63, Chapter 9.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
