AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 67, Chapter 5, relative to delinquent property taxes.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-5-2415, is amended by deleting the language "return receipt requested." in subsection (e) and by substituting the language "return receipt requested, or any alternative delivery service as authorized by § 7502 of the Internal Revenue Code."

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming law, the public welfare requiring it.
