WHEREAS, Noah's Eagle project greatly contributed to the betterment of his community and reflected the true spirit of Volunteerism; and


WHEREAS, it is appropriate that we should pause to recognize Noah Price Erwin as one of the most outstanding young people in our State; now, therefore,
