A RESOLUTION to call a joint convention of the Senate and House of Representatives for the purpose of hearing the State of the State address by Governor Bill Haslam.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED SEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that the Senate and House of Representatives meet in joint convention on Monday, January 30, 2012, at 5:45 p.m. (CST) in the chamber of the House of Representatives for the purpose of hearing the State of the State address by the Honorable Bill Haslam, Governor of Tennessee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Governor Haslam be invited to address the joint convention on Monday, January 30, 2012, at 6:00 p.m. (CST) in the chamber of the House of Representatives.
