AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 68, Chapter 24, Part 6, relative to functions that may be performed by alcohol and drug abuse counselors.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

- SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-24-606, is amended by deleting the existing language in its entirety and substituting instead the following:
  - (a) The purpose of this section is to adopt nationally recognized and accepted professional practice domains for licensed alcohol and drug abuse counselors.
  - (b) The professional practice domains and transdisciplinary competencies in which licensed alcohol and drug abuse counselors may engage are as follows:
    - (1) Clinical evaluation;
    - (2) Treatment planning;
    - (3) Referral;
    - (4) Service coordination;
    - (5) Counseling;
    - (6) Client, family, and community education;
    - (7) Documentation; and
    - (8) Professional and ethical responsibilities.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect on July 1, 2013, the public welfare requiring it.
