AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 10, Chapter 7, Part 5, relative to public records.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-504(f)(1), is amended by adding the following language as a new subdivision thereto:

(H) Personal, non-government issued, email address;

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-504(f)(1), is amended by adding the following language between the language "former employee," and the language "or of any law enforcement officer":

or applicant to such position,

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-504(f)(1)(F), is amended by adding the following language between the language "immediate family members" and "or household members":

, whether or not the immediate family member resides with the employee,

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-504(a)(18), is amended by adding the following language between the language, "agencies," and "or higher education institutions":

political subdivisions,

SECTION 5. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 10-7-504(a), is amended by deleting subdivision (17) and substituting the following:

(17) The telephone number, address and any other information which could be used to locate the whereabouts of a domestic violence shelter, family safety center or rape crisis center may be treated as confidential by a governmental entity, and shall be treated as confidential by a utility service provider as defined in subdivision (a)(15) upon the director of the shelter, family safety center or crisis center giving written notice to the records custodian of the appropriate entity or utility that such shelter, family safety center or crisis center desires that such identifying information be maintained as confidential. The records of family safety centers shall be treated as confidential in the same manner as the records of domestic violence shelters pursuant to § 36-3-623.

SECTION 6. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
