AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39, Chapter 17; Title 53 and Title 63, relative to controlled substances and prescription drugs.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-436(a), is amended by deleting subdivisions (1)-(5) and substituting the following instead:

- (1) Section 39-17-418 involving any substance listed in § 39-17-408(d)(2);
- (2) Section 39-17-431; or
- (3) Any felony offense prohibited by this part; or
- (4) Conspiracy to commit, attempt to commit, or solicitation to commit any of the offenses listed in subdivisions (a)(1)-(3).

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-436(f), is amended by deleting the language "methamphetamine registry" and substituting instead the language "drug offender registry".

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-436(e), is amended by deleting the language "seven (7) years" and substituting instead the language "ten (10) years".

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014, the public welfare requiring it.
