A RESOLUTION to designate January 27-February 2, 2013, as "School Choice Week" in Tennessee.

WHEREAS, Tennessee has many high-quality teaching professionals in public, private, and charter schools across the state who are committed to educating children; and

WHEREAS, the vital cause of education reform is one that transcends ideology and political party affiliation; and

WHEREAS, research in Tennessee and across our nation demonstrates conclusively that providing children with multiple schooling options improves academic performance; and

WHEREAS, School Choice Week is a nationally celebrated event, and during this week we join with millions of parents, educators, schools, and organizations around the country to raise awareness of the need for effective educational options that challenge and motivate all our students to succeed; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, that we hereby designate January 27-February 2, 2013, as "School Choice Week" in Tennessee and urge all citizens of our great State to raise their awareness of the need for effective educational options for all students.
