WHEREAS, in an effort to raise additional funds for their wish granting endeavors, Make-A-Wish of Middle Tennessee is hosting "A Super Bowl to Remember"; a family-friendly event that allows donors to socialize, dine, and enjoy the 2013 Super Bowl, all while contributing to a worthy cause; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that members of this Legislation pause to acknowledge the Make-A-Wish Foundation of Middle Tennessee for their continuous efforts to enrich the lives of children with life-threatening illnesses; now, therefore,


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that an appropriate copy of this resolution be prepared for presentation with this final clause omitted from such copy.
