WHEREAS, the Lady Commander coaching staff did an excellent job of preparing the team for the challenges of competition; and

WHEREAS, head coach Randy Alley is a sixteen-year veteran of coaching TSSAA volleyball; assistant coach Deanna Teeter has served as the head girls' basketball coach at FCS for the past eleven years; and assistant coach Chase Alley was a member of the 2010 Junior Olympic impact volleyball championship team; and
