WHEREAS, this General Assembly is pleased to specially honor and commend those successful high school athletic teams that, through their magnificent exploits, bring honor to Tennessee and serve as exceptional ambassadors of this State; and

WHEREAS, the Riverdale High School Lady Warriors basketball team is one such estimable team. The Lady Warriors recently won the 2012-2013 TSSAA AAA Basketball State Tournament Championship, a fitting end to a spectacular undefeated season which saw the team tally thirty-five wins and climb to the top of the national rankings of MaxPreps and ESPN; and

WHEREAS, after advancing to the state tournament championship game at the Murphy Center on the campus of Middle Tennessee State University, Riverdale High School captured the AAA State Girls' Basketball Championship with a hard-fought, 78-69 victory over the team from Science Hill High School. WHEREAS, the dedication, determination, work ethic, and talent of this group of young women not only made possible a memorable championship season, but also surely point toward their success in every future endeavor; and
