WHEREAS, Sheldon's Eagle project greatly contributed to the betterment of his community and reflected the true spirit of volunteerism; and


WHEREAS, it is appropriate that we should pause to recognize Sheldon Kappel as one of the most outstanding young people in our state; now, therefore,
