HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 171

A RESOLUTION to commemorate "National Church School Day" and "Back to Church School Crusade Months".

WHEREAS, the members of this General Assembly are proud to recognize and commend those estimable spiritual leaders whose service to their respective communities can only be categorized as outstanding; and

WHEREAS, in 1968, Evangelist Nettie B. Rogers of Memphis, because of her desire to improve the quality of life for those around her, founded and chartered Memphis Inter-Denominational Fellowship, Incorporated, which she established as a means to build spiritual and moral fiber, promote Christian and public education, eliminate crime and juvenile delinquency, and reduce illiteracy; and

WHEREAS, when launching its signature program, the "Back to Church School Crusade," in 1970, Memphis Inter-Denominational Fellowship, Incorporated, enlisted the assistance of the mayor of Memphis, who proclaimed the first Sunday in June as "National Church School Day"; and

WHEREAS, Shelby County government later joined with the city of Memphis, and in 2005, a joint City and County proclamation was issued designating June 5, 2005, as "National Church School Day"; similar proclamations were issued by the Memphis and Shelby County governments in 2007, 2008, and again in 2009 and subsequent years; and

WHEREAS, placing vulnerable youth in an atmosphere of dedication, devotion, and understanding is an important step toward eliminating crime, delinquency, and so many of the other blights that plague our nation's cities; and


WHEREAS, to honor the legacy of the late Evangelist Nettie B. Rogers and her desire to improve her community and country by advancing opportunities for youth, all places of worship, clubs, organizations, and affiliated groups are encouraged to participate in the commemoration of "National Church School Day" and "Back to Church School Crusade Months"; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, that we hereby join with the citizens of Memphis and Shelby County as they commemorate June 2, 2014, as "National Church School Day" and June 2-July 26, 2014, as "Back to Church School Crusade Months" in their efforts to contribute to the positive development of this state's youth.
