SENATE RESOLUTION NO. 17

A RESOLUTION relative to firearms and ammunition.

WHEREAS, Tennesseans across the state have expressed their genuine concerns that the federal government is poised to restrict or abolish the right of the people to keep and bear firearms and ammunition; and

WHEREAS, the right of the people to keep and bear firearms and ammunition is clearly guaranteed by the Second Amendment of the United States Constitution; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, that this body hereby expresses its firm intention and resolve to fully marshal the legal resources of the State of Tennessee to judicially challenge and overturn any effort by the federal government to restrict or abolish the right of the people to keep and bear firearms or ammunition.
