HOUSE BILL NO. 2628

AN ACT to amend Chapter 192 of the Private Acts of 1953; as amended by Chapter 197 of the Private Acts of 1990 and Chapter 141 of the Private Acts of 2002; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the Gibson County Utility District of Gibson County, Tennessee.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 192 of the Private Acts of 1953; as amended by Chapter 197 of the Private Acts of 1990 and Chapter 141 of the Private Acts of 2002; and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended by deleting the following language in Section 4:

The commissioners taking office September 1, 2002, shall serve no more than two (2) full four-year terms in addition to any term of less than four (4) years.

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of Gibson County. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the legislative body and certified to the secretary of state.


SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 2.


