# **PUBLIC CHAPTER NO. 633**

### SENATE BILL NO. 1966

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-16-603, relative to evading arrest.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-16-603(b)(3), is amended by deleting the subdivision and substituting instead the following:

(3)(A) Except as provided in subdivision (b)(3)(B), a violation of this subsection (b) is a Class E felony and shall be punished by confinement for not less than thirty (30) days.

(B) If the flight or attempt to elude creates a risk of death or injury to innocent bystanders, pursuing law enforcement officers, or other third parties, a violation of this subsection (b) is a Class D felony and shall be punished by confinement for not less than sixty (60) days.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-16-603(a), is amended by deleting the language "intentionally flee" and substituting instead the language "intentionally conceal themselves or flee".

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016, the public welfare requiring it.
