AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 40, Chapter 33, Part 2, relative to the issuance of forfeiture warrants.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-33-204, is amended by deleting subdivision (c)(3) and substituting instead the following:

(3) General sessions judges may not authorize magistrates or judicial commissioners who are not licensed to practice law in this state to issue forfeiture warrants.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
