WHEREAS, a lifelong resident of Hamilton County, he evinces his devout religious faith as an active member of Dallas Bay Baptist Church in Hixson; and


WHEREAS, it is appropriate that we should pause to recognize Michael Monroe as one of the most outstanding young people in our state; now, therefore,
