SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 39

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Connie King of Clarksville to the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-1-201, provides for the creation of the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-1-201, further provides that the Governor shall appoint nine members to the commission; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Haslam has appointed Connie King of Clarksville to a term that will expire on February 28, 2021, as a member representing the 6th District; and

WHEREAS, Connie King and her husband, David King, are the owners of Midsouth Shooters Supply Company. After purchasing the business in 1995, they relocated it to Clarksville, where they now employ forty-five individuals; and

WHEREAS, an avid outdoorswoman, Mrs. King enjoys hunting, fishing, and the shooting sports, in addition to reading and staying active in her church; and

WHEREAS, Connie King is a person of integrity and an active citizen whose benevolence, acumen, and strong commitment to public service have helped to enhance the well-being of this State and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-1-201(b)(1), provides that each member appointed to the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission by the Governor shall be confirmed by the House Agriculture and Natural Resources Committee; the Senate Energy, Agriculture and Natural Resources Committee; and Joint Resolution of the General Assembly; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED NINTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING, that we hereby confirm the appointment of Connie King to serve on the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission for a term that will expire on February 28, 2021.
