

SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 40

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of David Watson of Lookout Mountain to the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-1-201, provides for the creation of the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-1-201, further provides that the Governor shall appoint nine members to the commission; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Haslam has appointed David Watson of Lookout Mountain to a term that will expire on February 28, 2021, as a member representing the 4th District; and

WHEREAS, a graduate of the University of Tennessee, Knoxville, Mr. Watson is the coowner and a partner of Mountain View Auto Group and chief executive officer of Mountain View Ford Lincoln; and

WHEREAS, an avid fly fisherman, Mr. Watson has fished all over the western United States, Alaska, New Zealand, and Argentina; he is also an enthusiastic turkey, waterfowl, and upland game hunter and holds a Tennessee Lifetime Sportsman License; and

WHEREAS, David Watson is a person of integrity and an active citizen whose benevolence, acumen, and strong commitment to public service have helped to enhance the well-being of this State and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-1-201(b)(1), provides that each member appointed to the Tennessee Fish and Wildlife Commission by the Governor shall be confirmed by the House Agriculture and Natural Resources Committee; the Senate Energy, Agriculture and Natural Resources Committee; and Joint Resolution of the General Assembly; now, therefore,
