WHEREAS, Anne Thompson is survived by her daughter, Elizabeth Sims Thompson Rice; sons, John Dee and George Walter Thompson; four granddaughters; and two grandsons; and

WHEREAS, Mrs. Thompson leaves behind an indelible legacy of integrity and probity in public life, compassion and loyalty in private life, and diligence and dedication in all her chosen endeavors; and
