## PRIVATE CHAPTER NO. 53

HOUSE BILL NO. 2707

AN ACT to amend Chapter 589 of the Private Acts of 1949; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to pyrotechnics.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 589 of the Private Acts of 1949; and any other acts amendatory thereto, is repealed in its entirety.

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of Blount County. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the legislative body and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it shall become effective as provided in Section 2.




