AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 10 and Title 4, Chapter 29, Part 2, relative to the Tennessee advisory commission on intergovernmental relations.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-29-238(a), is amended by deleting subdivision (44).

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-29-242(a), is amended by inserting the following as a new subdivision:

( ) Tennessee advisory commission on intergovernmental relations, created by § 4-10-102;

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-10-105, is amended by adding the following language as a new subsection:

( )(1)(A) Any member who misses more than fifty percent (50%) of the scheduled meetings in a calendar year shall be removed as a member of the commission.

(B) Subdivision ( )(1)(A) shall not apply to members appointed under § 4-10-103(a)(1),(2), and (11), or the commissioner of finance and administration if appointed under § 4-10-103(a)(7).

(2) The executive director of the commission shall promptly notify, or cause to be notified, the appointing authority of any member who fails to satisfy the attendance requirement as prescribed in subdivision ( )(1)(A).

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.


