## **PUBLIC CHAPTER NO. 146**

**SENATE BILL NO. 693**

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 48, Chapter 101, relative to persons involved in the solicitation of charitable funds including fund raising counsel and professional solicitors.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 48-101-501(8), is amended by deleting the subdivision in its entirety.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 48-101-503(a), is amended by deleting the language ", professional fund raising counsel,".

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 48-101-504(a)(2)(F), is amended by deleting the language ", fundraising counsel,".

SECTION 4. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 48-101-504(c)(3), is amended by deleting the language "and/or fund raising counsel".

SECTION 5. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 48-101-507, is amended by deleting subsection (b) in its entirety.

SECTION 6. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 48-101-507(c)(3), is amended by deleting the language "or fund-raising counsel" wherever it appears in the subdivision.

SECTION 7. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 48-101-513(g)(1), is amended by deleting the following language:

the names and residence addresses of each employee or other person who is working in connection with such campaign, and the account number and location of all bank accounts where receipts from such campaign will be deposited.

and substituting instead:

and the names and residence addresses of each employee or other person who is working in connection with such campaign.

SECTION 8. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 48-101-513(h), is amended by deleting the subsection in its entirety.

SECTION 9. For administrative and rule making purposes, this act shall take effect upon becoming law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, this act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
