AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 62, Chapter 3 and Title 62, Chapter 4, relative to shampooing.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-3-108, is amended by adding the following as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

() Any person whose occupation or practice is confined solely to shampooing, as defined in § 62-4-102;

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-4-109(a), is amended by adding the following as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

() Any person whose occupation or practice is confined solely to shampooing;

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-4-110, is amended by deleting subsection (e) in its entirety and redesignating the remaining subsection accordingly.


SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
