### HOUSE BILL NO. 18

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 56, relative to prescription eye drops.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 56, Chapter 7, Part 23, is amended by adding the following as a new section to be appropriately designated:

A policy or contract for a health benefit plan, as defined in § 56-7-2203, that is issued, renewed, or entered into on or after January 1, 2018, and provides coverage for prescription eye drops shall not deny coverage for a refill of a prescription that is a covered benefit under the policy or contract of the insured and is otherwise eligible for a refill if:

(1)

(A) The renewal is requested by the insured for a thirty (30) day supply of the drug at least twenty-three (23) days from:

(i) The original date the prescription was dispensed to the insured;  
or

(ii) The date the most recent refill was dispensed to the insured;

(B) The renewal is requested by the insured for a sixty (60) day supply of the drug at least forty-five (45) days from:

(i) The original date the prescription was dispensed to the insured;  
or

(ii) The date the most recent refill was dispensed to the insured; or

(C) The renewal is requested by the insured for a ninety (90) day supply of the drug at least sixty-eight (68) days from:

(i) The original date the prescription was dispensed to the insured;  
or

(ii) The date the most recent refill was dispensed to the insured

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.


