AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 21, Part 4; Title 38; Title 47, Chapter 18, Part 17 and Title 62, Chapter 26, relative to background checks conducted for employment purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-26-223(b), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision:

( ) A person engaged exclusively in the business of obtaining and furnishing information regarding a candidate for employment to the candidate's potential employer;

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
