Hill Award Honorable Mention at Reach Them To Teach Them 2014, the 2011 Making a Difference Award for more than twenty-five years of service to the Knox County Science Department, and the Water Quality Forum Award for Adopt-A-Watershed from 1997 through 2005; she was the Fulton High School Teacher of the Year for 1993–1994, 2001–2002, and 2003–2004; and
