A RESOLUTION to recognize and honor the African American Heritage Society of Rutherford County.

WHEREAS, the members of this General Assembly are pleased to recognize those community-based organizations and associations that have as their aim the preservation of local historical heritage; and

WHEREAS, one such estimable organization is the African American Heritage Society of Rutherford County, a nonprofit organization established in 2014 to discover, preserve, teach, and share the heritage and history of African Americans in Rutherford County; and
