WHEREAS, no stranger to honors and awards, Rodney Archer was named East Tennessee Trustee of the Year in 2010, Tennessee Trustee of the Year in 2015, and a Top 30 under 30 Business Leader by the *Greater Knoxville Business Journal* in 2013; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Archer has completed the work as trustee that he felt was essential for Anderson County's success in the future; and

WHEREAS, Rodney Archer is wholly committed to the noble precepts of public service that have earned Tennessee recognition as the Volunteer State, and he should be specially recognized; now, therefore,
