HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 745

A RESOLUTION to honor and commend Eric Hicks.

WHEREAS, the members of this General Assembly are proud to pause in their deliberations to honor those Tennesseans who are committed to helping their fellow citizens fight opioid addiction; and

WHEREAS, Eric Hicks, plant manager of Jones Plastic & Engineering in Camden, is one such commendable individual, who has set upon a path to help rehabilitate those employees who suffer from drug addiction; and

WHEREAS, when Mr. Hicks arrived at Jones Plastic & Engineering in 2013, approximately fifteen percent of workers were absent each day; the turnover rate was close to seventy-five percent; and it was not uncommon for all of the individuals at a typical job orientation session to fail the mandatory drug test; and

WHEREAS, concerned about the well-being of his employees and the productivity of his plant, Eric Hicks settled upon an uncommon solution to his plant's problems: he decided to approach those employees suffering from drug addiction and offer them help; those employees who accept assistance are referred to nearby treatment centers and allowed to return to their jobs once they have completed treatment; and

WHEREAS, since employing this non-traditional approach, Mr. Hicks has not only helped his employees conquer drug addiction, but he has also boosted his plant's productivity; turnover, absenteeism, and drug test fail rates have dropped significantly, as well as the number of defective parts made, all of which lower costs and increase profits; and


WHEREAS, unlike the typical employer, Eric Hicks has chosen to extend compassion and support to those suffering from drug addiction; his novel approach to drug addiction in the workplace is a model that others would do well to emulate; now, therefore,
