A RESOLUTION to honor and commend Representative Steve McDaniel for his honorable and astute service to the people of Tennessee as a member of the House of Representatives.

WHEREAS, as an active and dynamic participant in the legislative process, Representative McDaniel rendered sterling service as a member of the House Agriculture and Natural Resources Committee, the House Finance, Ways and Means Committee, the House Conservation and Environment Committee, the House Health and Human Resources Committee, the House Calendar and Rules Committee, the House Government Operations Committee, the House Budget Subcommittee, and the House Agriculture Subcommittee; and

WHEREAS, a member of the Joint Council on Pensions and Insurance, Representative McDaniel has served as chair of the House Rules Committee, the House Ethics Committee, and the House Finance, Ways and Means Study Subcommittee; and

WHEREAS, Representative McDaniel is a member and former chairman of the Douglas Henry State Museum Commission, a former member of the Tennessee Civil War Sesquicentennial Commission, and a former member and National Chairman of the Board of Directors of the American Legislative Exchange Council; and

WHEREAS, Steve McDaniel attended Jackson State Community College and holds a Bachelor of Science degree from the University of Memphis. He is the city manager for Parkers Crossroads, the former restaurateur, president, and general manager of Cotton Patch,

WHEREAS, a gentleman who truly appreciates the responsibilities, as well as the privileges, of leadership and citizenship, he has donated his time and energies as president of the Henderson County Chamber of Commerce, and as a member of the Chester County Chamber of Commerce, the Decatur County Chamber of Commerce, the Wayne County Chamber of Commerce, the Perry County Chamber of Commerce, and the Jackson Area Chamber of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, a past president of the Henderson County Historical Society, Representative McDaniel is a member of the Tennessee Civil War Preservation Association and the Civil War Trust, historian for the Parkers Crossroads Battlefield Association, and chairman of the biennial Battle of Parker's Crossroads Living History and Battle Reenactment; and

WHEREAS, he is a former chairman and member of the Board of Directors of the Tourism Association of Southwest Tennessee and a member of the Henderson County Possum Club and Pvt. Ike Stone SCV Camp #564; and

WHEREAS, throughout his outstanding career as a legislator, Steve McDaniel has worked tirelessly on behalf of his constituents, bringing to his office an honorable bearing and the traditional values of hard work and common sense; and

WHEREAS, his many civic and professional accomplishments aside, Steve McDaniel is most appreciative of the love and companionship he shares with his wife, Phyllis Taylor McDaniel, and their daughter, Andrea McDaniel Smith and her husband Adrian, and grandson Zeke; and
