WHEREAS, an Eagle Scout, Mr. Reed is active with the Boy Scouts of America in the Highland Rim District, helping many young men join the Eagle Court of Honor; and

WHEREAS, a Mason and a Shriner for more than fifty years, Mr. Reed has served as a Dickson County Commissioner for the last eighteen years; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Reed evinces his devout religious faith as a lifelong Methodist, and he has served on many mission trips around the world; and

WHEREAS, Booty Reed is grateful for the love and companionship he shares with his wife, Ernestine Still Reed; he is the loving father of three children and the treasured grandfather of five grandsons and five great-grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, through his estimable service to Dickson County, Mr. Reed epitomizes the spirit and commitment that are characteristic of a true Tennessean; and

WHEREAS, the members of this General Assembly find it appropriate to acknowledge and applaud Booty Reed for his dedication to the State of Tennessee and its citizens; now, therefore,
