WHEREAS, Ms. Brown's noteworthy achievement is a tremendous source of pride for her family, her school, and her community; and


WHEREAS, Ms. Brown's dedication to excellence is clearly deserving of the respect, admiration, and commendation of the members of this General Assembly; now, therefore,
