WHEREAS, participants of the conference attended action-oriented sessions and engaged in important discussions on such topics as financial well-being, health, and political participation; and


WHEREAS, the conference facilitated meaningful conversations and empowered attendees to continue their efforts toward positive change in their respective communities; now, therefore,
