A RESOLUTION to honor and congratulate the Maplewood High School boys' basketball team upon winning the TSSAA Division I Class AA State Championship.

WHEREAS, the members of this legislative body are pleased to specially honor and commend those successful school athletic teams that, through their magnificent exploits, bring honor to Tennessee and serve as exceptional ambassadors of this state; and

WHEREAS, one such exemplary group of student-athletes is the Maplewood High School boys' basketball team, which achieved an extraordinary level of success during the 2016–2017 season by capturing the Tennessee Secondary School Athletic Association (TSSAA) Division I Class AA State Championship; and

WHEREAS, traveling to the Murphy Center at Middle Tennessee State University (MTSU), the Maplewood Panthers made their way across the bracket by defeating Sullivan East High School by a score of 71–55 and Haywood High School by a score of 57–56; and

WHEREAS, this magnificent team includes Joshua Osborne, Warren Fisher, Timetric "Bo" Hodges, Craig Blackshear, Timotheus "Bobo" Hodges, Deshawn Johnson, Justin Cross, Jaylen Alexander, Anthony Cockrill, Robert Wilcox, Marcus Rhodes, Austin Anderson, and Hassan Littlepage; and

WHEREAS, Panthers Hassan Littlepage, Robert Wilcox, and Timotheus Hodges were all named to the All-State Tournament team, and two-time Mr. Basketball Timetric Hodges was chosen as the Class AA Tournament Most Valuable Player; and

WHEREAS, these state champions all benefited from the vast knowledge and stellar guidance of their head coach, Tyron Wilson, who won the title of 2016–2017 Coach of the Year, and assistant coaches, John Hopson and Jaleel Queary; and
