WHEREAS, a credit not only to the Mt. Juliet and Wilson County communities but also to the entire Volunteer State, the Mt. Juliet League provides Tennessee's children with experiences that promote irreplaceable lessons in sportsmanship and camaraderie; and

WHEREAS, it is most appropriate that the members of this legislative body recognize the Mt. Juliet League and the many wonderful people who are involved with this worthwhile endeavor; now, therefore,
